Inspection of the Boys and their Uniforms. (20 marks)

A random selection of movements at the halt: Attention, Stand at Ease, Left-Turn, About-Turn, etc. (**Commands to be given by one of the Judges**) (20 marks)

Each team shall be required to undertake the following moves:

Single File around the hall (10 marks)

Rectangle Maze (Page 15 – Diagram 2) (20 marks)

The Snowball (Page 30 – Diagram 19 Stage 1) (10 marks)

The Diamond (Page 38 – Diagram 25) (20 marks)

Counter Marching In Two Files (Page 22/23 – No Specific Diagram) (20 marks)
Diagrams shown on Pages 22/23 are only examples.

Pick Up A Partner (Page 34 – Diagram 21 (ii)) (20 marks)

Passing In Four Files (Page 24 – Diagram 12) (20 marks)

Weaving Option i (Page 25 – Diagram 14) (20 marks)

The Snowball Reversed (Page 32/33 – Diagram 20 Stage 1 and 2) (20 marks)

Figure of Eight (Page 37 – Diagram 24) (20 marks)

Single File around the hall (10 marks)

Extra marks given by Judges for **use** and effectiveness of music and general smartness etc. when marching. (20 marks)
